Important Rules

- Research the terrains and the route you are planning to go in, and Evaluate your party' skill level properly.
- Check the weather, snow conditions, and avalanche advisory.
- Carry appropriate equipment for avalanchae 3 Measures goods, Food, Water, Map, Mobile phone etc











Submit a "Climbing Plan Report" to a local mountain police office. "Climbing Plan Report" can play an important role for search and rescue in a case you have an emergency situation.

"(Controlled) Ski area"

... Ski courses, ski slopes, and other areas maintained and controlled for skiing and snowboarding by a ski resort company. It is also referred just as "ski area" in this leaflet. The area beyond the ski area is called "uncontrolled area". Skiers/ snowboarders should follow the instructions by ski patrol and the rules defined by the resort.

"Off-limits areas"

... Areas banned for skiers/snowboarders from entering. The area is usually marked with special ropes and signs. Offlimits areas are prohibited due to collision risks, risk to cause avalanches, dangerous terrains and other reasons.
